
## Revised CDPH COVID Guildelines

EFF. 3/13/23

Effective 3/13/23; Notable updates pertaining to schools are:

- Persons can return to work/school after a 5 day isolation period having been fever free for 24 hours, with mild/resolving symptoms, even WITH a positive covid test.
- After ending isolation, students may remove their mask sooner than Day 10, with two sequential negative tests one day apart.
