It was a wonderful night to celebrate by enjoying a delicious meal, networking and hearing updates from experts in the field. Fran Sutton from CHOC provided trends in diabetes care. Doctors Allred and Han from Southern California College of Optometry spoke on vision issues. We also wish to thank all the districts who donated baskets for the opportunity drawings. NASN has recently worked with congressional champions to craft the NURSE Act (Nurses for Under-Resourced Schools Everywhere Act), which was introduced in the Senate and House concurrently on School Nurse Day, May 8. The NURSE Act would give grants from the Department of Education to increase the number of registered school nurses in Title I schools where a school nurse does not already exist. We all know that children's health and learning are linked. School nurses work as child health and safety experts at the intersection of health and education. NASN is encouraging people to contact their legislators and lend their support. The NASN website provides examples of what to say and how to contact your representatives.
